Under the Aegis of Late W Bro Harshadray Joshi Memorial Lodge Fellowship Corona Relief Project, on 1st May 2020 Lodge Fellowship distributed ration kits to 12 jobless families, about 59 people in Gheekanta area of Ahmedabad who had completely run out of food and money.

Bro Abhishek of Lodge Fellowship No. 140 came to know of their plight and requested if something could be done to help them. Our





treasurer Bro R.P. Verma immediately sent a request to the brethren of Lodge Fellowship, which was unanimously agreed. Incidentally it



was also the birth anniversary of Late W Bro Harshadray Joshi.

Bro Yatin Patel very kindly agreed to source the ration kits costing Rs. 9,000/= and the same were handed over in coordination with Bro



Abhishek to Vipul Bhai, the representative of the 12 jobless families of Gheekanta area.

Each Ration kit consisted of the following:

Atta – 7 kg., Rice – 5 kg., Moong Dal – 2 kg., Tea – 200 gms., Sugar – 2 kg., Moong – 1 kg, Jaggery – 1 kg, Cooking Oil – 1 kg, Masalas etc.

A further appeal for contributing funds was made to the brethren of Lodge Fellowship for procuring 100 PPE kits (costing approx. Rs. 490/= each). It was indeed heartening to see that the brethren responded immediately and within a couple of hours Rs. 50,000/= was



collected. The PPE kits have been ordered and we expect the delivery in the next couple of days.

Bro Jayesh Modi of Lodge Fellowship was generous enough to come forward and donate 2000 masks for distribution.

The PPE Kits and Masks will be distributed in the coming week by Lodge Fellowship No. 140.

In continuation of our Covid Relief project another 50 PPE kits costing Rs. 22,000/- were delivered on 07/05/20 to Lokhandwala Hospital, that AI Amin Trust & ISSA Trust are supporting for treating Covid Patients in Ahmedabad. We had 2 years ago also donated an ambulance to the AI Amin Trust.
